- Are you currently involved in basic and/or clinical research projects? If yes, please describe the topic/field of your research (short description).

Scientific contribution

In the application, please also indicate whether you would like to contribute scientifically:

- Poster presentation
- Oral presentation (talk)

If you plan to present, please include a tentative title and topic of your contribution.

Optional post-congress observership (1 week)

After the congress, scholarship recipients may optionally participate in a one-week clinical observership at a German dermatological hospital.

Please indicate in your application:

- No, I do not wish to participate

Selection process

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the organizing committee based on the submitted application documents.
